The OCVTS Academy of Law & Public Safety (ALPS) offers a unique and comprehensive foundation of skills for Ocean County students interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement. Enrollment in this full-time educational program is open to incoming high school sophomores and juniors (September 2018). ALPS provides a challenging, hands-on learning experience for college-bound and career-oriented students. Students receive a rigorous academic program which meets New Jersey high school graduation requirements and prepares students for admission to competitive colleges and universities. This program explores the role of law and public safety and homeland security in the United States and career opportunities in various law enforcement agencies. Articulation agreements with Ocean County College and Georgian Court University have been established to provide students with an opportunity to earn advanced college credit upon successful completion of this program.
