RE: TPAF Members - Ocean County Selection of Delegates and Alternates

This is to inform you that the Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund (TPAF) Board of Trustees has determined that Ocean County is entitled to 22 delegates and 11 alternates for representation to elect a trustee position for a three-year term commencing on January 1, 2022, from Group B. The delegates and alternates must be active or retired members of the TPAF.

Please note that two eligible candidates are seeking the aforementioned position, therefore this year there will be an election.

N.J.A.C. 17:3-1.4 sets forth the procedures for the selection process of a member-trustee.

The method by which election voting will take place will be an electronic ballot. The delegates and alternates will cast their votes via their respective Member Benefits Online System (MBOS) accounts. All delegates and alternates must have an MBOS account in order to vote.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:3-1.4, the County Superintendent's Office is required to electronically submit the Certification of Delegates and Alternates to the Board Office by May 31, 2021.
